Currently District 2 does not have a director.

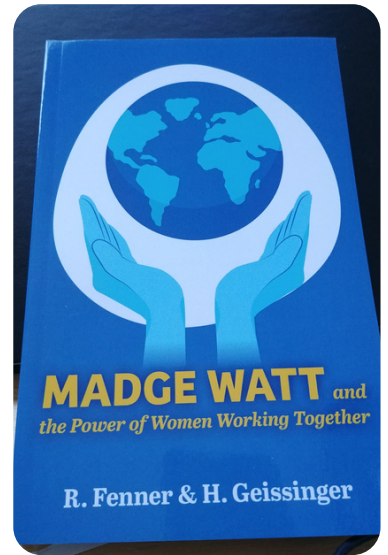
