Alberta Association on Gerontology (AAG) Survey

AAG needs your help. Can you complete this short survey?

By 2046, a striking 20% of Albertans—the aging baby boomers and their echo boomer children—will be 65 years or older. Next year, the first baby boomers turn 75. If we persist with the status quo, the operating costs of continuing care will double by 2032. Innovative solutions are imperative in tackling this looming care crisis head-on.

AAG is engaged in a significant consultation process (see AAG website, <https://albertaaging.ca>) to understand what needs to change. The upcoming work includes a Community Forum (web-based session in early March 2024) bringing people together from a variety of communities to discuss and share learnings about their lived experiences and leading practices for addressing inclusion and diversity in the care of older persons. To facilitate the planning of the Community Forum, the AAG wishes to receive your input about the content and potential speakers for the Forum.
